- **Glass** needs to be in its own container.
- We take **Motor Oil** in sealed containers, set beside recycling box

Paper

Tips to ensure recyclability: Remove anything that's not a part of the paper product, such as Styrofoam, food contaminates or packaging.

- Newspaper, Magazines & Catalogs
- Cardboard
- Brown Paper Bags
- Paper Egg Cartons
- Cracker/Cereal Boxes
- Broken Down cardboard Boxes
- Mixed & School papers (no glue, glitter, paint)
- Junk Mail (Paper, Envelopes)
- Office Papers (File Folders, Fax Paper, Shredded Paper)
- Wrapping, Posters & Packaging Paper
- Phone Books

Tin/ Aluminum

Tips to ensure recyclability: All cans need to be free of food contaminates.

- Canned Foods
- Beverage Cans

Glass

Tips to ensure recyclability: All glass needs to be free of food contaminates.

- Bottles And Jars
